

#### NOTICE OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY SEALED BID PUBLIC TIMBER AUCTION

Notice is hereby given that the St. Louis County Auditor shall sell to the highest bidder the designated timber located on the following described parcels of land forfeited to the state for the nonpayment of taxes, which have been classified and appraised as provided by Minnesota Statutes 282.04, Subd. 1(1982); and that this auction may include other lands which the St. Louis County Land and Minerals Department is authorized to manage, subject, in part, to the following conditions:

- To be eligible to bid at a St. Louis County Timber auction, a Responsible Operator Application Form must be on file at the St. Louis County Land and Minerals Department, 320 West 2nd Street, Suite 302, Duluth, MN 55802, at least 2 (two) working days prior to the auction. An application can be obtained at any Land and Minerals Department Office.
- 2. The timber will be sold to the highest bidder but for not less than the total appraised **Tract Value**. A <u>bid value per unit</u> must be indicated for each species listed. This bid value will be applied to each specie. Bid value per unit must meet or exceed the appraised bid value per unit. St. Louis County reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids.
- 3. All bid forms must be received in the Land and Minerals Department's Duluth Government Services office by 4:30 P.M. on February 14th. All bids must be on the official bid form.
- 4. A \$300 bid bond, i.e. personal check, payable to the **St. Louis County Auditor** is required and must be included with the bid form. One bid bond will cover all tract bids and will be returned if the bids are not the successful bidder. For a successful bidder, the bid bond will be applied to the down payment on the first tract awarded.
- 5. Successful bidders will have **10 business days** to submit a check, payable to the County Auditor, for **15%** of the appraised tract value for each tract awarded. Failure to make any or all of these down payments on time will result in the forfeiture of the bid bond. Successful bidders will be notified by mail.
- 6. Should the successful bidder not submit the down payment on time, the sale may be awarded to the next highest bidder. In the case of tie bids, the successful bidder will be decided by the toss of a coin by a deputy auditor.

Forest products offered are certified to the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI®) Standard according to the Land and Minerals Department's SFI® certificate unless otherwise indicated in the "Comments" section for the tract and corresponding contract document.

Many of the tracts have special requirements. The St. Louis County Land and Minerals Department offers sales of various sizes, species, and products to meet the needs of a wide variety of purchasers.

There are some sales offered on this auction that allow the purchaser to decide if they want to purchase the sale as offered, or choose to have all the species sold as SOAV. These are identified with the following sentence in the comments of each tract: "The purchaser has the option to purchase this sale as advertised or to purchase all species as Sold On Appraised Volume (SOAV)". SOAV species are intended to include the entire above ground portion of the tree, including residuals and may be removed at the discretion of the contractor, unless otherwise specified. Roundwood measure is shown for bidding purposes only, and does not include any estimate of residuals. SOAV species are to be sold based on the appraisal without scaling.

Producing biomass from merchantable roundwood of scaled species may be allowed if consumer scaling requirements are met. Please contact the Sale Administrator for more information on this process.

For contracts offering the option of choosing Sold On Appraised Volume (SOAV), successful bidders must elect to choose this option when paying the down payment pursuant to Minnesota Statute 90.14.

Timber Sale Operators must have the following minimum training for at least the owner of the firm and the foreman who will supervise the logging on St. Louis County Tax Managed Lands:

- Master Logging Certification; or
- Minnesota Logger Education (MLEP) Member in Good Standing; or SFI Training FISTA member: or
- Training equivalent to the Minnesota SFI Implementation Committee Training Standard for a trained Professional Logger.

All field employees must have training in best management practices.
