Public Works & Transportation Committee

Musolf/Harala moved that pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 163.02 and § 117.012 et. al., the St. Louis County Board authorizes the County Attorney to acquire the right-of-way necessary for County Project CP 0142-860298, SAP 069-742-005 through eminent domain proceedings, payable from Fund 220, Agency 220793. [24-257]. Public Works Director Jim Foldesi commented that the project will start in 2025 and part of the right-of-way for 2025 construction has not been acquired through negotiation and direct purchase. Negotiations will continue; however, beginning the eminent domain process will ensure construction project timelines are met. The motion passed. (7-0)

Public Safety & Corrections Committee

Grimm/Harala moved that the St. Louis County Board approves the purchase of standardized equipment through multiple cooperative agreements: Imprivata Single Sign-On, CDW-G, \$ 40,467.25, Sourcewell #121923; Cisco Firewall, Insight, \$167,239.62, Omnia Partners #23-6692-03; Dell PC's/Docks, NowMicro, \$354,736.78, MN State Contract #160321, Dell/NASPO #MNWNC-97222, MHEC;

CradlePoint Modem/Antennas, CDW-G, \$176,242.92, Sourcewell #121923; Ivanti Software, CDW-G, \$12,000.43, Open Market, with a total cost of \$750,687 payable from Fund 100, Agency 117051, Object 634802, with funds transferred from the Information Technology assigned fund balance, Fund 100, Object 311139; and further, authorizes appropriate county officials to sign agreements necessary for future maintenance of the mobile data computers modernization project, which will be subject to annual cost increases as outlined in the maintenance agreements. [24-258]. Information Technology Director Jeremy Craker commented that the current technology is 12-15 years old, which has caused connectivity issues. The motion passed. (7-0)

Central Management & Intergovernmental Committee
