

#### NOTICE OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY PUBLIC ORAL TIMBER AUCTION

Notice is hereby given that the St. Louis County Auditor shall sell to the highest bidder the designated timber located on the following described parcels of land forfeited to the state for the nonpayment of taxes, which have been classified and appraised as provided by Minnesota Statutes 282.04, Subd. 1 (1982); and that this auction may include other lands which the St. Louis County Land and Minerals Department is authorized to manage, subject, in part, to the following conditions:

- 1. To be eligible to bid at a St. Louis County Timber auction, a Responsible Operator Application Form must be on file at the St. Louis County Land and Minerals Department, 320 West 2nd Street, Suite 302, Duluth, MN 55802, at least two (2) working days prior to the auction. An application can be obtained at any Land and Minerals Department Office.
- A minimum of fifteen (15) percent of the appraised value shall be paid immediately following the auction along with obtaining contractor signature. Fully signed contracts will be mailed to winning bidders after the auction. The remaining balance shall be paid prior to entry. <u>REQUIRED DOWN</u> PAYMENT IS SPECIFIED ON LIST.
- 3. Minimum bid shall be the appraised value of the sale. Bids shall be at one (1) or more percent over and above the appraised prices. The final percent bid is to be added to the price of each kind of timber advertised, unless otherwise stipulated in individual contract regulations. Species denoted as No Bid will not be subject to the percent bid increase.

St. Louis County Land and Minerals Department does not accept cash payments.

#### Please Note:
